Dear Parents of Rising Sixth Graders,

Let me begin by thanking you for your patience, as I know many of you were wondering when you would hear from Camp Road Middle School (CRMS) about registering your child for our middle school. Converting all of our former processes from pencil/paper to digital platforms has been challenging at times, while continuing to deal with the daily events of our new way of operating schools. I now have some information to share.

1. Charleston County School District (CCSD) has directed middle schools to accept all of our rising sixth graders who are **zoned** to attend our school without registering. This means you do not have to complete the standard registration form; nor do you have to submit the notarized Affidavit and two proofs of residency.
2. However, if you are not a James Island/Folly Beach resident, you will not be scheduled to attend CRMS unless you have an approved District transfer for the 2020-21 school year.
3. Students are scheduled for academic classes based upon the district middle school honors rubric. That honors rubric is explained on the attached FAQ sheet.
4. Parents and students do get to choose related arts classes. An electronic registration form will be sent Monday, May 18, and families have until May 30 to complete the registration form.
5. The district has been working on a video of the new school. The expected completion date is May 15, so I am hoping it will be emailed to all families on May 22.
6. Fact and Fee Night will be scheduled during the week of August 10. At that time families will pay their school fees, receive their child's class schedule, and may take a tour of the new facility.
