

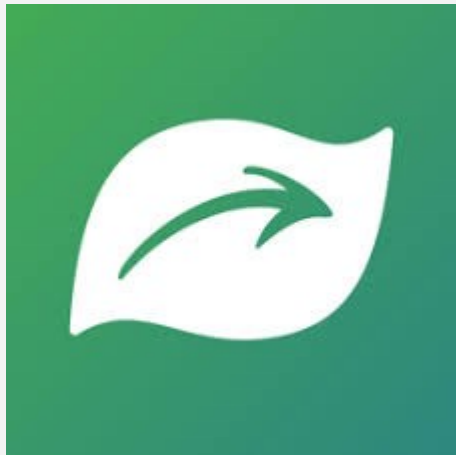
# LBHS SCIENCE IN THE SUMMER
