

Deer Park Middle School Uniform Expectations 2022-2023

Scholars are expected to be dressed in accordance with this policy at all times school is in session. The goal of this policy is to assist scholars in presenting themselves in a manner that is conducive to a safe and orderly learning environment. Families are encouraged to monitor their scholar's dress to ensure compliance. Deer Park Middle will require all scholars to wear the approved uniform. School uniforms encourage scholars to express their individuality through personality and academic achievements and creates a sense of school pride and belonging.

Failure to follow a dress code or any other direction given by the school can involve disciplinary action. These include: warning, clothing loan, phone call home, ISS or suspension, consequences will not supersede the CCSD PDP.

Identification Cards: All scholars will be issued ID cards at the start of school. The ID will display the scholar's name, picture, and a bar code for checking out library and textbooks, and lunch. Scholars must display the ID card with a lanyard on their shirts at all times. The picture side of the ID must be facing forward, and scholars may not write on, carve, or alter the ID in anyway. Replacement ID's and lanyards will be sold for \$5.00.

Shirts and Tops, Outerwear

- Short or long-sleeve collared polo shirts, sweaters, in black, hunter green, purple, or grey
- Deer Park spirit wear is acceptable and encouraged any day of the week
- Under shirts/turtlenecks can be worn under the polo shirt but must be black, hunter green, purple or gray ONLY.
- No emblems, logos, decorations, or decorative trim will be allowed.
- No Hoodies

Bottoms, Jumpers, Dresses, Pants, Capris, (Shorts, Skorts, and Skirts clothing may not be above the student's fingertips)

- Bottoms must be solid khaki, or black, (Dockers style) with no holes or cuts
- Dresses may be any solid color and must have a collar and sleeves.
- A belt is required if the garment has belt loops
- Pants must be appropriately fitting - no sweatpants, baggy or sagging pants will be allowed
- No Spandex, leggings, or jeggings allowed unless worn under the skirt, skort, or shorts
- No emblems, logos, decorations, or decorative trim will be allowed

Shoes

- Appropriate school shoes (tennis/athletic/sneakers/dress/casual) must be worn at all times
- Shoes with laces must be laced and tied at all times
- Open-toed or open heel shoes are not permitted
- Flip flops sandals, slides, Crocs, bedroom shoes including slipper boots, athletic slippers, and shoes with wheels are not permitted.
