School Doors open at 8:05 AM and the tardy bell rings at 8:30 AM

*\*\*Students not in the building at 8:30 AM are TARDY\*\**

Dismissal begins at 3:20 PM

*Half-Day bell time: 11:45 AM*

To pick a child up, the parent or guardian must be on the Emergency List or a handwritten note must be sent stating who will be picking the child up.

A Driver's License/Photo ID is required to sign a child out of school.

*Transportation changes may not be made after 2:45 PM. All transportation changes must be made in writing with the child's name and date included.*

<p>Arrival/ Dismissal</p>	<p><u>Arrival:</u>  Car Riders: Arrival procedures begin promptly at 8:05 AM. Once your car is along the sidewalk, students may exit the car. Please make sure students have said all of their goodbyes, have all of their materials ready to go, and are prepared to hop out of the car when you pull up to the drop-off zone. Staff will be outside to monitor arrival, but students are responsible for opening their own car door.</p> <p>Students are considered tardy after 8:30 AM. After this time, an adult must bring the student into the office to sign them in.</p> <p><u>Dismissal:</u>  The dismissal process will begin at 3:20 p.m. Dismissal will begin with car riders, bus riders, and Kaleidoscope will be dismissed.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">**All students must be picked up by 3:45 PM.**</p> <p>Adults picking up students must have an official E.L. Frierson identification tag to pick up students, these tags will have the student's name and must be visible. This is an added security measure and will help streamline dismissal to be more efficient and timely. If you do not have the E.L. Frierson identification tag with you, you must park and bring your driver's license into the office for your student to be released.</p>
<p>Attendance</p>	<p>Students must be signed in by a parent/guardian in the front office if arriving at 8:30 AM or after. Please keep in mind on a normal school day, in order for your child to be marked present, they must attend school no less than 3.5 hours. Example: If you are signing in tardy due to a scheduled doctor's appt., you must sign your child in before 12:00 PM for them to be counted present for the day. If you are signing your child out early, they must be signed out after 12:00 PM to be counted present for the day.</p> <p><b>All parent excuses and/or doctor's excuses must be sent in within three days of the child's return back to school. Please include your child's full name, the date(s) of absence, and a parent's signature in parent-written excuses. Excuses should be handwritten and sent in with your child.</b></p> <p>Please note: there will be NO student sign-outs after 2:45 PM as we are preparing for dismissal.</p>

Frierson bus chart.</p> <p>Look for the bus stop with the nearest cross-street to you. The AM and PM times when the bus will be at this stop are on the chart. Make a note of your bus number and the street name. Please communicate this to your child's teacher.</p> <p>If you do not see a bus stop within 0.4 miles from your house, you can request a stop on the CCSD Transportation website.</p> <p>Plan to be at your bus stop 10-15 minutes early.</p> <p>There are instructions on how to sign up for bus delay notifications on the Transportation site. <i>Expect the first week of school to have delays!</i></p>

<p><b>Drop Off Materials</b></p>	<p>If you are dropping off materials after school starts for your student, please ring the doorbell and you will be let into the vestibule. Please give your item to a front office staff member with a label stating your child's name and teacher. If you get the chance, please send the teacher an email letting them know you dropped an item off.</p> <p>We will do our best to get your item to your child as soon as possible. Please note that there is no guarantee it will get to your child on the same day. If you forgot a lunch, we have free lunch all year, and your student can pick up one of those if you forget. We also have water bottles here for any student that doesn't have one.</p>

<p>School Security</p>	<p>The Security and Emergency Management team's mission is to promote and support an environment that fosters life safety and the continuation of the learning process within the Charleston County School District. Identification is always required to pick up a student. If someone other than the parent/guardian is picking your child up early from school, a handwritten note with that person's full name as it appears on their driver's license and time</p>

	<p>of pickup must be sent in with the child that morning. The school office nor the teacher can accept phone calls, emails, faxes, or text messages. This policy is put into place for the safety of our students. Visitors should ring the school doorbell and identify themselves and their purpose for visiting before entering the building.</p> <p>Fire, hurricane/tornado, and lock-down drills are conducted regularly.</p> <p>To help our youngest elves, primary students will have a red tag on their backpacks with student information (name, class, bus stop, or afterschool program).</p> <p>All car riders will be given a car rider identification tag. This must be displayed visibly during pickup.</p>
<p><b>School Supplies and Instructional Fees</b></p>	<p>Edith L. Frierson Elementary does not charge instructional fees. <p><b>Student Number</b></p>	<p>All students are assigned a PIN number upon registration. Check with your child's teacher or the front office for this PIN if you do not have it prior to school starting.</p> <p>Student PIN numbers stay with them through graduation and are used to help identify the student for meal payments, student records, online education portal identification, K5 tags, etc.</p>
<p><b>Tardies</b></p>	<p>Once a student receives five tardies, a parent letter will be sent home. After that, If the student receives two additional tardies, the parent will be required to come in for an administrative problem-solving conference.</p> <p>If your student is at our school on an Approved District Transfer, they may not receive more than five (5) tardies in one semester or 18 weeks, or they risk having their transfer revoked.</p>
<p><b>Truancy</b></p>	<p>SC State Law says a child is truant if they miss (3) consecutive or (5) cumulative days absent in a school year that is not due to illness, medical, bereavement, or legal reasons. Vacations and/or out-of-town trips scheduled within the 180-day school year are not considered excused absences and may result in your child reaching a "truant status." Once a child is considered "truant," an administrative conference will be required to put a "Truancy Intervention Plan" into place for the remainder of the school year.</p>

<b>Uniforms</b>	School uniforms keep students focused on their education, create a level playing field among students, and reduce peer pressure and bullying. Wearing uniforms enhances school pride, unity, and community spirit. Edith L. Frierson's uniforms are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Navy blue, baby blue, yellow, and white collared shirts</li><li>● Navy blue, baby blue, yellow, and white sweaters and sweatshirts</li><li>● Navy blue and khaki pants, shorts, jumpers, and skirts</li><li>● Closed-toe tennis shoes or soft-soled shoes</li></ul>
<b>Volunteers</b>	We love and appreciate our volunteers! Guidelines will be updated when we have received updated guidance from our CCSD/MUSC task force for the 2023/2024 school year. Per CCSD, volunteers and chaperones must pay a \$5.00 fee to be cleared through our Raptor security system.
