The random lottery selection of students to determine eligibility is influenced by priorities listed under Application Priorities.

Transportation to and from centralized locations is provided to all students who live in Charleston County and attend Countywide Magnets.

**Grade Offered: 9 - 12**

## Application Priorities (in order):

1. Student living in Charleston County who has a sibling currently attending Lowcountry Tech Academy
2. Multiple siblings applying and living in Charleston County (If one is accepted, the next sibling is given priority.)
3. Student of CCSD employee living in Charleston County
4. Student living in Charleston County
5. Student of CCSD employee and then student living out of Charleston County but eligible to attend CCSD magnet/choice schools
