## Focus/Description

Frierson Elementary School became District 9's first Montessori School in the 2018-19 school year. Frierson Elementary is a Montessori Magnet serving zoned students and District 9 students through application.

Frierson currently has 3 Primary classes of 3, 4, and 5-year-olds and a 3rd Lower EL Class of 6, 7 and 8-year-olds. In the fall of 2022 an Upper L for 4th grade will be added to Frierson's Montessori program. As students move up in age, new classes will be added until Frierson has a full Montessori program, Primary to Adolescent.

## School Category: Montessori Magnet (D9)

Montessori Magnet schools are those with a prescribed attendance zone within a Constituent District coupled with the opportunity for students to apply for seats available after all the attendance zone students have been placed.

Transportation is provided to magnet students attending Montessori Magnets within the Constituent District in which the school is located.

**Grades Offered: PreK-3 - 3rd grade Montessori; adding a level each year. Traditional program will continue for 5th grade in 2022-2023.**

**Application Grades: PreK-3, 4, 5 year olds; LE: Grades 1, 2 and 3**

## FEMP Application Priorities (in order):

1. Student living on Wadmalaw Island
2. Student living in Charleston County who has a sibling currently attending Frierson Elementary Montessori Program
3. Student living on John's Island
4. Multiple siblings applying and living in Charleston County (If one is accepted, the next sibling is given priority.)
