Focus/Description

Hursey serves its students with the Montessori philosophy and the instructional and curricular support of the philosophy. Hursey Montessori is a school-wide Title I school based on our percentage of students on free/reduced lunch. This is a federally funded program. Our funds are used to reduce class size and ensure appropriate resources are available to each student.

School Category: **Montessori Magnet (D4)**

Montessori Magnet schools are those with a prescribed attendance zone within a Constituent District coupled with the opportunity for students to apply for seats available after all the attendance zone students have been placed. Transportation is provided to zone students attending this category of schools according to normal transportation regulations.

Transportation is provided to Magnet students attending Montessori Magnets within the zone in which the school is located.

Grades Offered: **PreK3 - 8**

Hursey's Application Priorities (in order):

1. Student living in school enrollment zone
2. Student living in Charleston County who has a sibling currently attending Malcolm C. Hursey Montessori School
3. Multiple siblings applying and living (If one is accepted, the next sibling is given priority.)
4. Student of CCSD employee living in Constituent District
5. Student living in Constituent District
6. Student of CCSD employee living out of Constituent District and in Charleston County
7. Student living out of Constituent District and in Charleston County
8. Student of CCSD employee living out of Charleston County but eligible to attend CCSD magnet/choice schools
9. Student living out of Charleston County but eligible to attend CCSD magnet/choice schools
