Focus/Description

Frierson Elementary School became District 9's first Montessori School in the 2018-19 school year. Frierson Elementary is a Montessori Magnet serving attendance-zoned students and District 9 students through application. As students move up in age, new classes will be added until Frierson has a full Montessori program, Primary to Adolescent.

School Category: Montessori Magnet (D9)

Grades Offered: PreK-3-Grade 3 Montessori; adding a level each year.

Application Grades: PreK-3, 4, 5 year olds; LE: Grades 1-3; UE: Grades 4-6

Transportation: Provided to magnet students within the school's constituent district

Montessori Magnet schools are those with a prescribed attendance zone within a Constituent District coupled with the opportunity for students to apply for seats available after all the attendance zone students have been placed.

Application Priorities (in order):

1. Resides in enrollment zone
2. Resides in the constituent district with sibling currently attending
3. Student of CCSD employee resides in the constituent district
4. Multiple siblings applying [If one accepts a seat offer, the other receives this priority]
5. Resides in the constituent district
6. Resides out of the constituent district with sibling currently attending
7. Student of CCSD employee resides out of the constituent district and in Charleston County
8. Resides out of the constituent district and in Charleston County
9. Resides out of Charleston County with a sibling currently attending
10. Student of CCSD employee resides out of Charleston County
11. Resides out of Charleston County
