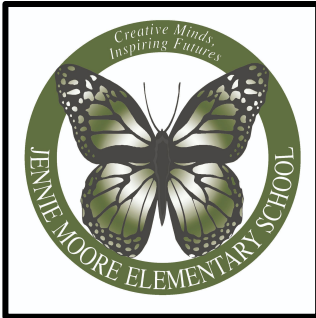

Transportation is provided to all students attending Constituent Magnets and living within that Constituent District(s).

Grades Offered: K - 5

JMS Application Priorities (in order):

1. Student living in school enrollment zone
2. Student living in Constituent Districts 1 or 2 who has a sibling currently attending Jennie Moore School for the Creative Arts
3. Multiple siblings applying and living in Constituent Districts 1 or 2 (If one is accepted, the next sibling is given priority.)
4. Student of CCSD employee living in Constituent Districts 1 or 2
5. Student living in Constituent District 1 or 2
6. Student of CCSD employee living out of Constituent District 1 or 2 and in Charleston County
7. Student living out of Constituent District 1 or 2 and in Charleston County
8. Student of CCSD employee living out of Charleston County but eligible to attend CCSD magnet/choice schools
9. Student living out of Charleston County but eligible to attend CCSD magnet/choice schools
