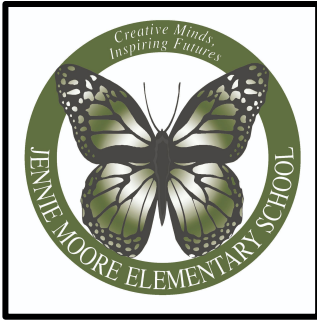

10. Student of CCSD employee resides out of Charleston County
11. Resides out of Charleston County
