JICHS Softball Tryouts for 7th and 8th Grade Students

JV and Varsity softball tryouts will be held on February 1st & 2nd from 4:00-6:00 pm on the JICHS Softball Field. The field is located in the “backyard” (behind the school) just past the Baseball field.

We encourage any students in grades 7-12 to come and try out!

Players must be registered on Planeths.com. A physical must be submitted BEFORE you can participate in tryouts! You only need one physical per school year. If you have seen your pediatrician in the last year, a form can be filled out by them. The physical form must be uploaded onto the site.

The form is available in the main office and on our athletic website. Players must have all of their paperwork completed and approved in planet high school. (physical, covid waiver, parent permission, concussion, birth certificate). If you are new and have not created an account for your player in Planeths – please do so ASAP.

Reminders:

- Be sure to bring a mask and plan to wear it.
 - Bring your own water bottle.
 - Please be on time.
 - If you are a catcher bring your own catcher’s gear.
 - Bring all of your softball gear including a helmet and bat if you have your own.
 - Please dress in appropriate Softball attire.
