PSAT for 8th graders is Wednesday, October 13

We will be administering the PSAT this Wednesday, October 13, to those 8th grade students who have signed up. Testing will take place from 8:30am-12:45pm. Please make sure your child arrives at school on time. We cannot allow late students to join once testing has begun. We also cannot interrupt testing or allow students to be signed out during testing.

Please have your child bring two sharpened no.2 pencils and a calculator for the test. They may NOT use a cell phone or smart watch to access a calculator. Page 24 of the Student Guide that was sent home with your child when he/she registered addresses calculator use.

To help make this a successful experience, please make sure your child gets a good night's sleep and eats a good breakfast. They may bring a small snack and a water bottle for the short breaks. Testing should be through in time for them to attend their regular lunch period.

A message from the Director of Hands of Christ:

Hands of Christ has been distributing school clothing to children in need in six counties of the Low Country area for eighteen years. With the COVID-19 crisis we have had to change our normal distribution at partner churches where children and parents could pick out their own clothing to one where a school fills out an order form, emails it back to me, and we pack individual bags and have a partner church, closest to the school, deliver them to the school.

Each school is allowed to order clothing for up to 60 children in need. To make sure we pack the right clothing we are asking for child's first name, gender, age, grade level, pants size, and shirt size. We give out one pair of pants (normally blue or khaki, long or short), one white polo style shirt, a pair of underwear, a pair of socks, and a bag of school supplies depending on the grade level. The partner church will be contacted when the bags have been filled and will contact the school official listed on the form to arrange delivery.
