Tuesday, November 2, Election Day, is a school holiday for students. However, teachers will be on campus for a teacher workday and will be available for family data conferences. The district has designated this day as "Family Data Conference Day". The purpose is to review your child's data dashboard of MAP scores, SC Ready and SC PASS scores. Attending a conference is **optional** and if you choose to attend a conference you have the choice of a face-to-face (mask required) or virtual conference. We realize that many parents may not be interested or able to attend a conference during the school day so the school will be sending all data dashboards home with students on Monday, November 1. Also in preparation for that, the October 31, *Cougar News* will contain a video with instructions on how to review your child's data dashboard if you are unable to attend a conference.

Please note that if you choose to attend a conference, you will need to sign up for one of the 20 minute sessions on the appropriate grade level **Sign up Genius link below**. This is not a parent/teacher conference to discuss your child's current grades or report card; it is strictly to review your child's data dashboard.

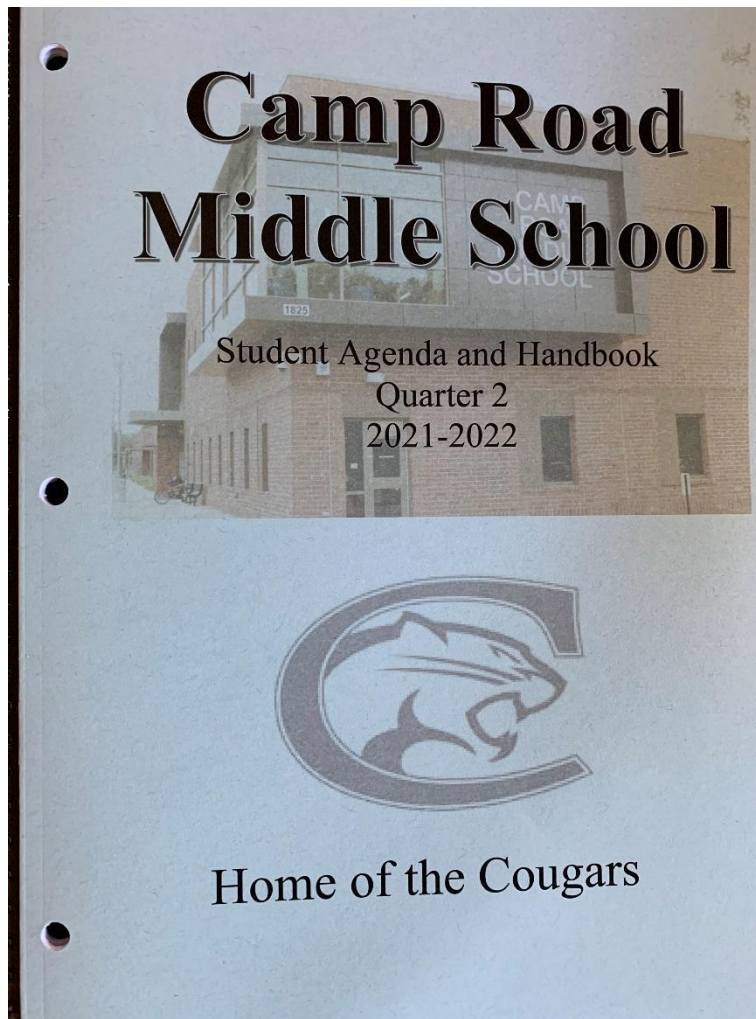

IT'S A NEW NINE WEEKS AND THAT MEANS...

1. All 6th graders will receive new schedules in homeroom because many of them will have changes in their related arts classes. Sixth graders in PE/Health, reading/math intervention, resource, strings, band, and chorus will **not** have those classes changed because they are semester or year-long classes. But students who were in computer literacy, journalism, French, Spanish, art, and design and modeling will change to another class for quarter 2 because each of these classes is for one nine-weeks.
2. Some 7th and 8th graders will be moved from one of their related arts classes to an Academic Intervention class because of failing grades in their Q1 core academic classes.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 28 IS REPORT CARD DAY AND FEDERAL CARD DAY

On Thursday of this week your child will receive his/her **Q1 report card**. Parents, please review the report card, sign it, and have your child return it to homeroom on Friday, October 29.

In addition, on Thursday your child will also be bringing home the annual **Federal Impact Aid Parent-Pupil Survey card**. You have seen this every year that your child has been in a public school. We need one returned for every child so please return this on Friday. The document is easy to complete if you do NOT live on government property, you are NOT employed by the foreign military, you do NOT work on federal property, or you do NOT serve in a branch of the military. If one of these **does apply to you**, you will need to take a few more minutes to complete survey card. We appreciate you attention to this document (**see below**).
