

C.E. Williams Middle School 2020-2021 Uniform Policy DRAFT



Uniform Requirements

- Solid (no patterns, stripes, or emblems larger than two inches) navy blue, royal blue, white or grey polo short or long sleeved collared shirts. Solid (no patterns, stripes, or emblems larger than two inches) navy blue, royal blue, white or grey button down collared dress collared shirts. MUST be worn with navy blue or khaki bottoms.
- Solid (no patterns, stripes, or emblems larger than two inches) white, navy, grey or royal blue crew neck or hooded sweatshirts (classic cotton or fleece). MUST be worn with navy blue or khaki bottoms.
- Solid (no patterns, stripes, or logos larger than two inches) white, navy, grey or royal blue cardigan-style sweaters. MUST be worn with navy blue or khaki bottoms.
- Any official C.E. Williams top (including sweatshirts) which includes CEW clubs, organizations, teams, current year's homeroom basketball shirts and approved shirts from school-sponsored events in which CEW learners participate/compete must be worn with navy blue or khaki bottoms OR jeans with no rips showing skin above fingertip length and no inappropriate writing. CEW logo must be visible.
- A CCSD High School Team shirt if the child is a current member of the team must be worn with navy blue or khaki bottoms OR jeans with no rips showing skin above fingertip length and no inappropriate writing.. High School logo must be visible.
- Undershirts must be solid white, navy blue, royal blue, or grey.

Dress Code

- All clothing should have a reasonable fit (not too large or too tight).
- Undergarments must be covered.
- Learners may not wear any clothing that reveals bare skin between the upper chest and waist. This includes clothing that reveals skin or undergarments by way of rips, tears, or holes in this area.
- Undergarments must be covered.
- All other sweaters, jackets, or sweatshirts may be worn as learners enter or leave the building (recess, mornings and dismissal, etc.).
- No pajamas, jeggings, spandex, corduroy, or athletic shorts should be worn unless permitted/directed by administration.
- Leggings or tights may be worn under the appropriate bottoms. **Leggings/Jeggings, yoga pants or spandex pants may not be worn as pants.**
- Shorts, skirts, skorts, and appropriate short sleeve dresses must reach the fingertips if shoulders are relaxed.
- Appropriate khaki or navy blue uniform dresses should be worn with a uniform polo style collared top or school-appropriate undershirt.
- Pants must be worn at the natural waistline. Belts are encouraged for pants with belt loops.
- Headbands that are not distracting.

- Hats, bandanas, hair picks, rags, hair caps, or scarves of any kind cannot be worn as headgear or accessories unless otherwise allowed by administration. Sunglasses may not be worn indoors. Transition lenses are permitted.
- Hoods may not be worn indoors.
- No backless shoes (straps across worn on the back of the foot are acceptable), open toed shoes, bedroom slippers, flip-flops are allowed for safety reasons. Shoes with laces must be laced and tied at all times. No shoes with wheels in them may be worn.
- Learners are allowed to carry purses the approximate size of a normal pencil pouch.
- Necklaces should be tucked inside of shirts.
- No clothing, jewelry, or accessory will be permitted that displays profanity, weapons, violence, suggestive phrases, alcohol, tobacco, drug advertisements or other inappropriate phrases or symbols as determined by the administration.
- Learners may not wear accessories or jewelry that may be considered unsafe as determined by the school administration. This includes but is not limited to facial piercings, gauges, chains and spikes.

CEW “Dress Down” Policy

- *There will be occasions on which learners will be permitted to dress out of uniform. Below are the guidelines for “Dress Down” days.*
- All sleeveless tops/straps should be at least three fingers wide.
- Sweatpants should not fit too tightly.
- All shorts and skirts must be fingertip length.
- No jeans/pants may be worn that have rips, tears, or holes that expose skin above fingertip length.
- No clothing may be worn with wording intended to draw attention to certain body parts or with suggestive language.
- Learners should not expose their chest/cleavage or midriff (in standing or sitting positions).
- Underwear and undergarments of any type shall be covered at all times.
- Refrain from wearing hats, caps, head stockings/do-rags, athletic style headbands, bandanas, head kerchiefs.
- The hoods of jackets or sweatshirts may not be worn indoors.
- No backless shoes (straps across worn on the back of the foot are acceptable), open toed shoes, bedroom slippers, or flip-flops or wedge heels are allowed for safety reasons. Shoes with laces must be laced and tied at all times. No shoes with wheels in them may be worn.
- No gloves may be worn in the building.
- No pajamas or beachwear allowed.
- No sunglasses may be worn indoors. Transition lenses are permitted.
- Pants must be worn at the natural waistline.
- Clothes that advertise alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, drugs, or other suggestive messages/merchandise (i.e. weapons, illegal substances) are not permitted.
- **Leggings/Jeggings, yoga pants or spandex pants may not be worn as pants.** Shorts or a skirt that is fingertip length must be worn over them.
