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## Logging Into MyPortal and Clever To Access Digital Resources

### MyPortal

- 1) Use **Chrome**-- MyPortal link will be just under the search bar or go to <https://myportal.charleston.k12.sc.us/>
- 2) **Students** will log in with their credentials:  
Username: (first 3 letters of your last name first 3 letters of first name last 4 numbers of student ID)  
Password: determined by school or student  
**Teachers** will log in with their CCSD network credentials
- 3) Click on the **Clever** icon
- 4) Choose **Log in with MyPortal**
- 5) Click on the icon for any of the digital resources students want to use-- the student is already logged into all the programs listed. They can switch from one program to another within Clever.
