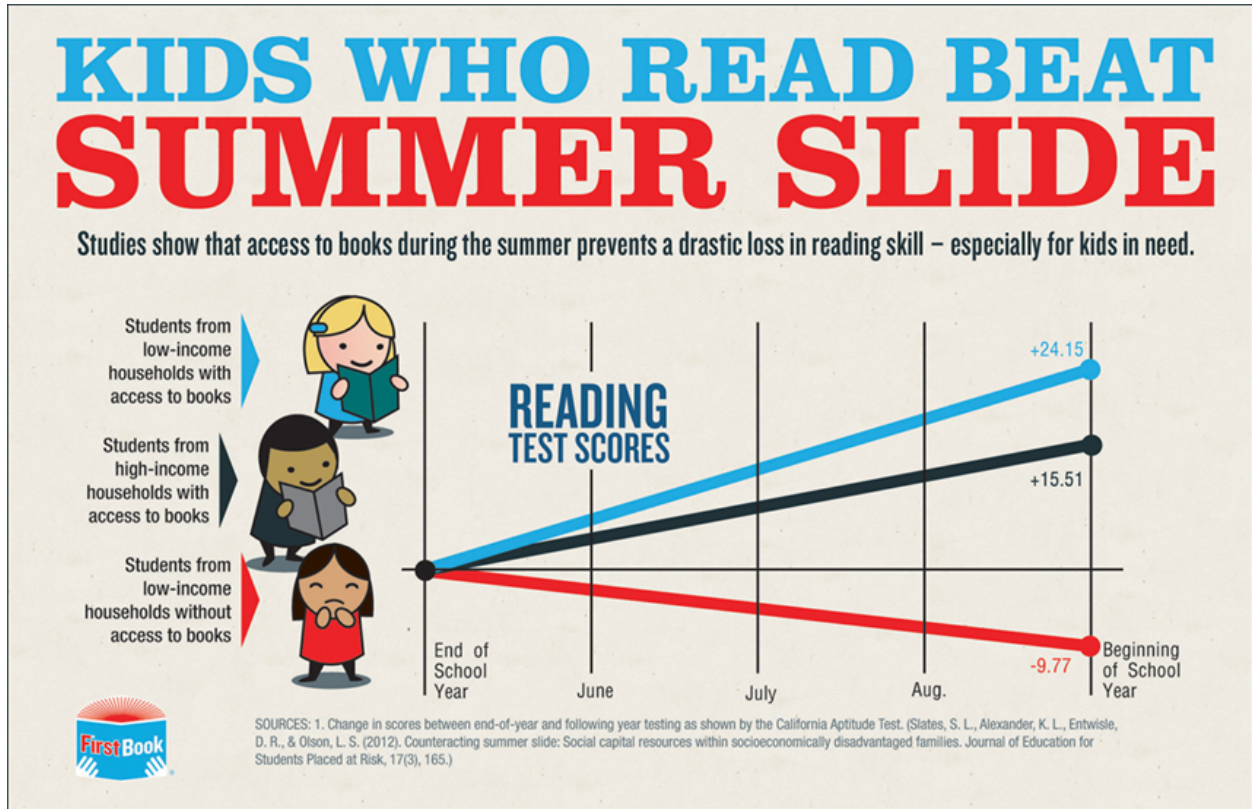


# Summer Reading is Highly Recommended and Expected at Haut Gap



## Earn extra rewards from Haut Gap (in addition to CCPL rewards) when you log reading in Beanstack from May 15 – July 31!

To prevent the summer slide, students should read 30 minutes at least 5 days a week.

### ❖ To qualify for the Reading Celebration at Haut Gap when we return to school:

1. Read and log 1000 minutes in Beanstack over the summer.
2. When school begins complete two Book Reviews in Beanstack or pass two AR quizzes.

### ❖ To qualify for the Reading Celebration and a t-shirt that can be worn each Wednesday:

1. Read and log 1500 minutes in Beanstack over the summer.
2. When school begins complete 3 Book Reviews in Beanstack or pass 3 AR quizzes.

*\*The criteria for Book Reviews will be given the first week of school with instructions on how to complete them.*

**Reading Expectations for 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade Magnet Students:** Read at least two (2) books with no less than 150 pages each and which are at the appropriate grade level/reading level for ELA 7 Honors or English 1 Honors. Projects will be assigned once the school year starts.
