Nick Reece selected as principal at Moultrie Middle

Charleston, SC – Charleston County School District (CCSD) is thrilled to announce Nick Reece as principal at Moultrie Middle School. Reece has served as interim principal at Moultrie for the past year. Prior to his time with the Patriots, Reece was an associate principal at West Ashley High School (WAHS) for five years.

In 2004, Reece joined the district as a seventh-grade science teacher at Thomas C. Cario Middle School. In addition to teaching during his nine years at Cario, Reece also served as an assistant administrator and as an assistant varsity swimming coach and boys basketball coach for Wando High School. Reece relocated out of state to Delaware (DE) beginning in 2014 where he joined Sussex Technical School in Georgetown, DE as a sixth-grade science teacher. The following year, he was promoted to assistant principal at nearby Delmar High School in Delmar, DE before returning to Sussex Technical as an assistant principal in 2016.

During his time at Sussex Technical, Reece supervised the CTE department which included 17 technical areas and 20 staff members. Additionally, he managed the Perkins funding items and served as the district testing coordinator. He also organized instruction for students receiving homebound services and managed teacher evaluations and improvement plans.

Reece returned to South Carolina in July 2018 and rejoined CCSD at West Ashley High School as an associate principal. During his time at WAHS, Reece helped organize professional development opportunities for Wildcat faculty and staff, created the master schedule and facilitated the student requesting process throughout the year, led the multi-tiered systems of support (MTSS) academic subcommittee as chair, and administered over 400 exams as the school's AP test coordinator. Since joining Moultrie last year, Reece has continued to positively impact school culture and climate by providing opportunities for staff and student recognition and has continued to increase student achievement and growth through data-driven instruction and coaching.

"Mr. Reece has done a fantastic job leading Moultrie Middle School this year," said Dr. Joseph Williams, Associate Superintendent of the Middle School Learning Community. "I know he will continue to take our middle school scholars to new heights with his dedication and commitment to excellence, access, and opportunity for all students."

Reece holds a Bachelor of Science in Health Science and a minor in Computer Science from James Madison University. He also earned a Master of Arts in Teaching in Secondary Education from The Citadel and a Master of Education in Secondary Administration and Supervision from Charleston Southern University.
