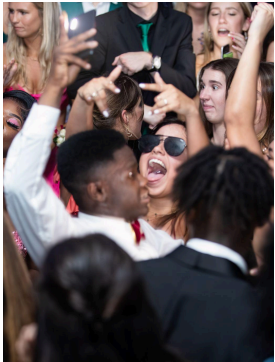
At a Glance– Major Deadlines:

- ❖ **Prom Tickets Go On Sale Monday, February 12, 2024**
- ❖ **Non-JICHS Guest Forms are Due no later than Friday, April 12, 2024.**
- ❖ **Prom Royalty Forms due by Friday, April 12, 2024**
- ❖ **Last day to pay JICHS Obligations is Sunday, April 21, 2024.**
- ❖ **Last day to buy Prom Tickets is Sunday, April 21, 2024. Cash is not accepted. Tickets will not be sold at the door.**



Obligation Fees & Prom Fees:

- ❖ The final deadline for ALL obligations must be paid by **Sunday, April 21, 2024.**
- ❖ Students with outstanding obligations will be refunded prom tickets and put on the Do Not Enter list until they have been paid.
- ❖ **Valentine's Special Pricing:** Feb. 8th- Feb. 29th- \$55/person, online payment.
- ❖ March 1st-March 22nd \$60/per person, online payment.
- ❖ March 23rd-April 12th- \$65/person, online payment.
- ❖ April 13th- April 21st- \$70/person, online payment.
- ❖ April 21st at 11:59 PM- Last day to buy Prom Tickets. Cash not accepted. Tickets not sold at the door.
- ❖ NO Refunds for Prom tickets. Ticket transfers may be possible. Let Mrs. Quinn know of all the changes.



Online Payments:

- ❖ Students wishing to pay for Prom fees must go to Revtrak on the JICHS school online store at: <https://jamesislandhigh.revtrak.net/> and then click on the “Prom” button to proceed. You will need to set up a login and password and have a check if you do not have an account already, set up with a check, debit, or credit card as payment. Make sure to include the student's name, grade, and guest when making online payments.

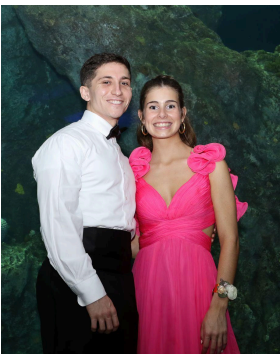


Prom Guest & Fees:

- ❖ Non-JICHS Guest tickets can not be purchased until the guest has been approved.
- ❖ Hard Copies of the Non-JICHS permission letter will be found in the Front Atrium, 120 & 123 Offices, Main Office, Attendance, and outside 932 in the PAC.
- ❖ Dates/guests must be at least a freshman in high school up to 20 years old as of the exact date of April 27, 2024 Prom...no younger or older.
- ❖ Non-JICHS Permission Forms and **valid ID** (with Date of Birth) are due by **Friday, April 12, 2024. to Ms. Quinn in Room 932.** Pictures of forms and IDs may be emailed/shared directly with Mrs. Quinn. **No Prom Guest forms will be received at the venue.**
- ❖ All guests must present their ID at the Prom to enter.

Prom Court Elections:

- ❖ All students wishing to run for Prom Court must fill out the [Prom Royalty Form](#) by **April 12, 2024.**
- ❖ Prom Elections: (Online Ballot) Opens Wednesday, April 24th through April 27th at 7 PM
- ❖ Royalty Results will be announced **during** the Prom on April 27th no later than 10 PM.





Prom Chaperones:

- ❖ The 2024 JICHHS Prom will be chaperoned by **JICHHS faculty & staff** assisted by City of Charleston Police Officers.
- ❖ Non-JICHHS staff chaperones will not be required.
- ❖ Parents and Guardians are not allowed to attend.

Prom Rules, Guidelines, and Expectations:

- ❖ Attendees to the JICHHS Prom must adhere to all JICHHS, CCSD, and legal laws and expectations. Guests will be expected to abide by the same rules.
- ❖ **Prom rules** include no alcohol/drugs/tobacco products, and no inappropriate behavior or negative interactions with other attendees. (See JICHHS Rules).

Guidelines For Attire:

It's your night to look your best for the "Golden Hollywood...A Night On the Town"

Here are a few things while planning your look:

Ladies: Wear formal Prom dresses or suits (no jeans). Long gowns and appropriate-length cocktail dresses suffice.

Gentlemen: Wear a tuxedo, suit, or coat and tie with dress pants with closed-toe shoes. (No jeans) Jackets are recommended but not required.

Avoid wearing any Halloween-type costumes (i.e. no full face masks, inflatable costumes, props, etc.)

Junior and Senior Prom Rules for James Island Charter High

1. All guests must have a valid picture ID to verify eligibility to attend a dance. NOTE: Guests coming to the dance who are not enrolled at JICHS must be under 21 but at least in the ninth grade to be eligible to attend the dance.
2. Any person currently suspended or expelled from Charleston County School District or any other school district may not attend a dance.
3. Students and guests agree to be subjected to a passive alcohol detector upon entry. Once you leave/exit the dance, you may not return. No loitering is permitted in the parking lot.
4. Students and guests agree to be re-tested with a passive alcohol detector based on reasonable suspicion of alcohol usage at any time during the event.
5. For safety reasons, dancers must avoid excess crowding together in the center of the dance floor. No body surfing allowed.
6. Proper Prom attire is required for attendance. For health and safety reasons, footwear and shirts are to be kept on at all times. Avoid wearing any Halloween-type costumes (i.e., no full-face masks, inflatable costumes, props, etc.)
7. Please do not leave valuables unattended. The school assumes no responsibility for the loss or theft of items.
8. Students must remember that the Charleston County School District and JICHS Code of Conduct apply to all participants at any school function, including dances. Failure to comply with the rules may result in potential loss of after-school activities and events or other disciplinary actions, i.e., marching at the Graduation ceremony, athletic events, etc.
9. Only students of JICHS coded as a current Junior or Senior may purchase tickets for entry, one for self and one for a guest (see above stipulations on guests). The guest must accompany the student to the event.
