Week January 19, 2022, Bell Schedules

As a reminder, there is no school for students **on January 17 & 18**. The second semester begins **on January 19, 2022**. We will have a modified bell schedule next week, January 19-21, which is below. We will have grade-level assemblies during CREW to review expectations for Independent Learning Time (ILT) and the senior privilege of leaving school during lunch. The attached draft expectations were developed with feedback from students, parents, staff, and the Board of Directors. We will make adjustments as needed. With increased supervision and clear expectations for students, we are giving ILT every chance to work. Most importantly, we need cooperation from our students. The plan is to begin ILT and the senior privilege starting Monday, January 24, 2022. Seniors may not leave for lunch until the required paperwork is complete and they have a special, second colored-coded student identification card.

Touchless Screening System

We are excited to announce the new touchless screening system is now operational at our school. Starting the second semester, all students must go through the screening process before entering the building. We will do a soft rollout this week by encouraging students to practice going through the screening system before school or at lunch to improve the efficiency of their experience. Adjusting backpacks can make a huge difference. At this point, Chromebooks and three-ring binders are setting off the system, which we expected. If items are removed before entering the building, students can place them on the adjacent table and walk through with the remainder of their belongings. Students do not need to remove other items such as cell phones or metallic water containers. With a bit of practice and preparation, every student should enter the building in less than a couple of seconds. Once we acclimated to the new arrival process, students are expected to be on time for class; therefore, some students may need to adjust their arrival time or morning routine. Waiting in cars to the last possible minute and entering as part of a mass group will cause unnecessary delays, which we will not excuse. This new screening system will ensure no weapons in our school with minimal inconvenience.
