**Freshmen, please be prepared to practice your summer work during Summer Scholars if you plan to attend**

### **Spanish 3**

**You must be prepared to present the following information about your summer the day you return to school.**

You must use complete sentences in Spanish. This will be a Q1 Project grade (20% of your grade)

- Basic Information
  - Your name
  - Your age
- What you did over the summer (use preterite and imperfect here)
  - Include at least 2 things you did and be descriptive - who were you with? How was the weather? Why did you (not?) enjoy this activity?

You also need to bring a collage without words that you can use as a prompt.

You need to be prepared to present and show your pictures on the first day of class. Please note the following:

- Your visual aid should be an 8.5"x11" paper
- You may draw or print pictures or create a collage
- You may **not** submit your work digitally
- You are NOT able to use notes or read your presentation.
- Your collage can be done on a computer if you'd prefer but it doesn't need to be printed in color

The follow rubric will be used to grade your presentation:

<b>Preterit vs Imperfect</b>	You used both the preterit and imperfect mostly correctly in a way that did not impede comprehension	You made some mistakes that began to impede comprehension and/or you only used one tense	You did not use either past tense
<b>Present tense</b>	You had few to no errors with present tense verb conjugation	Your use of present tense began to impede comprehension	You used infinitives and did not conjugate verbs when needed
<b>Collage / notes</b>	Completed Did not use any notes	Incomplete / turned in late Used a few notes	Not done Read from notes for entire presentation
