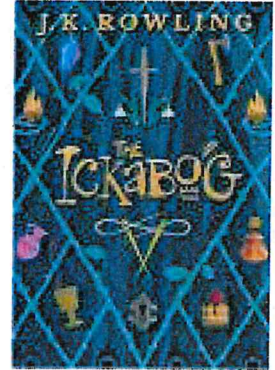


# Rising 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Summer Reading Orange Grove Charter Middle School 2022-2023 Ms. Fielding

All rising 7<sup>th</sup> grade OGCMS students will be required to read the following novel for Summer reading. You will begin your 7<sup>th</sup> grade ELA year with a novel study, short stories and children's cautionary/fairy tales, so thoroughly reading and understanding the novel is expected. Thanks!



Novel:

***The Ickabog*** by J.K. Rowling

**Students:** You are to choose **only ONE (1)** of the projects to complete based upon **this book that you read over the summer.**

- **DO NOT BRING YOUR PROJECT the first day/week of school.**
- **You will be assigned a day/time in which to present/discuss your project. Thanks!**

<p><b>PROJECT #1: Book Jacket</b></p> <p>Cut a piece of <i>WHITE poster board in half</i> (so that it measures 14x22)</p> <p><b>ON THE FRONT:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Create/Design (NO computer images accepted or tracing) a “new” cover for the book with a concept/idea from your book. <b>COLORFUL &amp; CREATIVE!</b></li> <li>● Include the <b>TITLE</b> and the <b>AUTHOR</b> on the <i>FRONT of your cover!</i></li> </ul> <p><b>ON THE BACK:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Write a biographical sketch of the book’s author</li> <li>● Write an <i>ORIGINAL review of the novel</i>- including both positive and negative thoughts- <b>DO NOT GIVE AWAY THE ENDING!</b></li> </ul> <p><b>** You may either hand write, NEATLY, your info on the back of the Book Jacket OR you may word process/print/glue your info **Ensure the biographical sketch is separate from the review!</b></p>	<p><b>PROJECT #2: Movie Poster</b></p> <p>Cut a piece of <i>WHITE poster board in half</i> (so that it measures 14x22)</p> <p><b>ON THE FRONT:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Design a “poster” for your book if it were to be made into a movie that shows a concept/idea from your book. <b>COLORFUL AND CREATIVE!</b> (no computer images accepted, no tracing)</li> <li>● The name of whom you would have as the <b>DIRECTOR</b></li> <li>● The name(s) of <i>famous actors/actresses (dead/alive)</i> whom you would have “playing” the parts of your characters</li> </ul> <p><b>ON THE BACK:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Explain how well your book would translate from novel to film</li> <li>● A <b>SHORT</b> review of your novel with likes &amp; dislikes ● An <b>EXPLANATION</b> of your choices for actors/actresses that would play the parts of your characters</li> </ul> <p><b>**You may either hand write neatly, your information, or word process/print/glue your information.</b></p> <p><b>**Ensure your review, translation, and choices for actors/actresses are SEPARATE entries</b></p>
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**PROJECT #3: MOVIE & SCRIPT**

- Type, print, and submit an original script for your movie
  - Your script will need to outline your actors names and the characters they are playing in the film •
- You may complete this project with other students as long as each of you participate in the writing/acting/filming/editing to get full credit. You may use friends/family members as extra actors
- **Your video must be at least 4 minutes long, without exceeding 10 minutes.**
