Mission Statement

The mission of Wando High School, in partnership with parents and community, is to educate all students by providing a challenging program of study, to encourage lifelong academic and applied learning, and to graduate students prepared to meet the challenge of a rapidly changing and diverse global society.



THE SCHOOL



Wando High School with an enrollment of approximately 2,700 students is located on a 100 acre campus in Mount Pleasant, South Carolina. Wando High School is a large, public non-magnet high school serving a diverse population of students in grades 9 - 12 with a comprehensive academic program offering more than 200 courses. Wando has maintained a reputation of academic excellence while providing rigorous standards in all areas for college and career readiness.

More than 25% of our students excel in the visual and performing arts. The Athletic Department has been the recipient of the South Carolina Athletic Administrators Association Carlisle Cup for the last eight out of nine years for Class AAAAA. This first place award is based on the rankings of the overall athletic program of the Class AAAAA schools. Wando competes in 23 sports with 38 teams.

Throughout the year, our students raise funds, collect resources, and serve alongside community members at various charities and events in support of those in need. Our students are encouraged to be involved in Wando life and "Walk the Warrior Way" with integrity, compassion, and personal responsibility.

FACULTY AND PROFESSIONAL STAFF

- Professional staff members have an average of 15.7 years of educational experience.
- 75% of the faculty and professional staff hold masters or other advanced degrees.
- 11 professional staff members are National Board Certified Teachers.

NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENTS

- Ninety-one percent of the 2022 graduating class planned to attend four-year colleges/universities, two-year colleges or technical colleges.
- Members of the class of 2022 were awarded over \$28.9 million in scholarships.
- 940 completer cords were worn by the Class of 2022 at graduation.
- Three hundred thirty-seven students in the Class of 2022 were named Charleston County School District Board Scholars.
- Four teacher cadets each received \$24,000 Teaching Fellows Scholarships.
- There were 87 Early Awards recipients for the South Carolina Palmetto Fellows Scholarship.
- Seniors took 931 dual credit courses with a passage rate of 88.2%.
- Three senior students received military academy appointments; one to the U. S. Air Force Academy, one to the U. S. Military Academy at West Point, and one to the U. S. Merchant Marine Academy.
- There are 456 members of the Advanced Placement Academy. Eighty-seven seniors in the Class of 2022 received special Advanced Studies certificates at graduation due to earning six or more AP credits.
- State championships were won in Boys Lacrosse, Girls Lacrosse, Girls Soccer, and Girls Swimming.
- One hundred ten Wando athletes were named to All-Region teams.
- Seventy-five senior athletes were named Scholar Athletes by the South Carolina High School League.
- Thirty-three student athletes committed to play at the college level.
- To graduate from high school requires earning 24 course credits. Wando seniors earned an average of 29 credits.
- The average GPA of the Class of 2022 was 3.80.
- Wando High School earned a silver medal from *U. S. News & World Report* as a 2022 Best High School.
- The Seal of Biliteracy was awarded to 50 Wando seniors.
- The Wando High School Orchestra earned the Outstanding Performance Award from the S. C. Music Educators Association for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Wando's Culinary Team competed at the FCCLA State Competition and came away with students winning Gold and Silver Awards. Five students will be competing in the National Competition in California.

Schedule

Wando operates on a hybrid schedule which can consist of any combination of these types of classes:

- 87/90 minute block class for one term
- 87/90 minute block classes for both terms
- 50 minute embedded classes for one or both terms
- 42 minute skinny class
- A/B day classes for selected courses
- College/dual enrollment courses meeting twice weekly
