(* recipients must remain Life and Palmetto Fellow eligible each year in college)</p> <p><u>There is no limit on the number of Charleston County students who can earn the scholarship but you must apply.</u></p> <p>If you have not completed the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to determine if you are Pell Grant eligible go here to do so ASAP.
