

## 21-22 Cario Middle Student Academic Quarantine Procedures

### STUDENTS:

- Always keep your Chromebook charged and ready for the needed school work times.
- If you leave school to quarantine, please take all of your books from your locker in case you need any of them
- Zooms for quarantined students are held after school hours (Monday - Thursdays) and Saturdays.
- Zooms on Monday - Thursday from 3:45 - 5:00 are to answer questions like how to access Canvas, to help explain assignments, and to help answer procedural questions. This will count as daily attendance.
- Check your **student email** to get needed Zoom links after 2:00 pm each school day (Monday - Thursday) and after 8:30 am on Saturday.
- Sign onto any Zoom using your full student name. Also, keep your video on the entire time you are on the Zoom so that you are visible to the teacher and can interact appropriately.
- Check your teachers' **Canvas** for daily assignments.
- Completing the work assigned on Canvas is your main job daily while at home on quarantine.
- Assessments will be assigned at teacher discretion.

### Saturday School Quarantine Schedule:

- Zooms will be set up per the following schedules to assist students on content-specific questions. Again, students need to check their student emails after 8:30 am to access the correct Zoom.

### PARENTS:

- Students in quarantine or out for any other reason will not be zooming into classes during regular school hours. Please do not email teachers asking them to allow your child into any zoom during regular school hours as this is not an option.
- Remind your child to check his/her student email daily for Zoom links and instructions
- Canvas is the primary source for assignments
