

St. John's High School Facts and Fees 2023-2024 (in the Gymnasium)

During Fact and Fee Day, you will be able to: Pay Current & Outstanding Fees, fill out forms for Lunch and Bus Transportation, take ID Pictures, Apply for Student Parking, obtain a schedule, collect information on Clubs, School Organizations, Athletics, and JROTC.

- <u>Student Fee</u>: 9th 10th 11th 12th Grades \$30
 Fees are used for additional instructional and related arts materials, innovative lesson implementation, virtual & in person field trips, ID badge supplies, school culture & student club supplies & materials.
- Senior Activity Fee: Senior Specific Events, Activities, and Graduation \$20
- Parking Fee: Juniors and Seniors who would like to park on campus \$50
 Submit: 1.) Parking Application 2.) Driver's License NO PERMITS

 3.) Current Vehicle Registration 4.) Current Insurance Policy
 If student has outstanding fees, campus parking will not be approved until account is paid in full.
 Parking on campus is a privilege to students who have no outstanding obligations to the school.
- <u>JROTC Fee</u>: Students who will be enrolled in the JROTC program will pay **\$50**. This fee supports the JROTC program events and activities.
- <u>Culinary Fee</u>: Students who will be enrolled in the culinary program will pay **\$25**. This fee supports certification and testing for the program.
- <u>Athletic Insurance</u>: All students who will be participating in any sport must pay **\$50** for District Athletic Insurance. Obtain Sports Physical Forms & instructions on completing sports enrollment in Planet HS
- <u>Yearbook</u>: 8/17 9/1 **\$20** 9/2 12/31 **\$25** After January 1, 2024 **\$30**
- <u>Prom Tickets</u>: Juniors and Seniors **ONLY** may purchase Prom Tickets on the following dates with designated pricing:
