

We are so excited to welcome you to Fact and Fee on Monday, 8/8, or the following Monday on 8/15. I wanted to send out some more information about our upcoming fact and fee days. Please be on the lookout for our back to school letter that will be coming out next week with important information about procedures and the start of school. Also, weekly communication (the Moultrie Minute) will begin again next Thursday and will continue through the end of the school year with regular updates about all that is going on at Moultrie Middle School. We are excited to see you and our Patriots soon!

Dates and Times for Fact and Fee

The dates and times for fact and fee for each grade level can be found on the flyer below. If you have two students at different grade levels, you do not need to attend this event twice. You can just attend which time frame is most convenient for your family and bring all students.

Parking and Entering for Fact and Fee

Families are welcome to park in the bus lot off of Ellis St or the main car loop off of Simmons St. Once parked, families will enter in the gym lobby towards the rear of the school from either side and proceed to the cafeteria. This will be the same for either day you want to attend fact and fee.

Registration

Please have the online registration completed before coming to Fact and Fee. We will have a place for families to complete registration if you have had trouble completing the process. Please note the whole process takes about twenty to thirty minutes from start to finish. If you need any help ahead of time, please feel free to call our office at 843-849-2819. There will also be a pop-up registration on 8/10 at Wando High School from 5:30 to 7:30 for those wanting to register there and go to the 8/15 Fact and Fee in the evening.

Stations at Fact and Fee

The following stations will be available at fact and fee:

1. Registration Check- This is the station we will have for anyone that hasn't registered yet or if you have to drop off materials you haven't been able to upload online. If you have completed registration, you can move straight from this station to the cafeteria.
2. Nurses Station- You will have a chance to drop off any medication or update any immunization cards here with the nurses. All emergency cards are now completed through the registration portal. Remember that ALL of your 7th grade students will need the T-Dap vaccination. You can also pick up any take home COVID tests if your family wishes.
3. Fee Payment- You will be able to pay school fees for the coming school year or any debts from the following year. If you have any books or devices to return from last school year, you can do so at this time. ***You can speed up the process at fact and fee and pay your school fees online before coming at this [site](#) (highly recommended).***
4. Schedule Pickup- We will print out your schedule for the coming school year!
5. Optional Counselor Help Station- If you need help reading your schedule or have an issue, a counselor will be there to help!

6. Uniform Pickup- If you ordered your uniforms before July 15th, you will be able to pick them up at this station. If you ordered your uniforms after the July 15th date, they will be delivered to your Patriots homeroom during the first few weeks of school. After you complete all of the stations, you will be able to roam the school and see your classes. I will also be available in the hallways to answer any questions you may have or would like to just say hey!

6th Grade Teacher Meet and Greet

On 8/8, from 9-11:30, we will have our 6th grade teachers here for you to meet and answer any questions you may have about the upcoming school year. You can see where your classes are and drop off any school supplies you may have with a teacher from your team. We are looking forward to meeting our new Patriots. 6th grade teachers will not be available on the 8/15 fact and fee date.
