- 1. <u>Meeting Called to Order</u>: Mr. Thomas L. Colleton, Chairperson, called the meeting to order, gave the invocation, and led the pledge of allegiance.
- 2. <u>Notice of Meeting</u>: In accordance with the S.C. Code of Laws, 1976, Section 30-4-80(d), as amended, the Charleston County Public Relations Office was notified of the time, date, place and agenda of this meeting, and the agenda was posted on the Charleston County School District web page, and St. James-Santee front office.
- **3.** <u>Adoption of Agenda</u>: Mrs. Harrell moved and Ms. Geathers seconded the motion to approve the agenda. The motion passed unanimously (5-0).
- 4. **Public Presentations and Recognition:** None
- 5. **Public Comments**: Ms. Garrett, parent, shared:
  - That students that live on the north side of McClellanville will have to travel approximately twenty- five miles to the new Doar Road school.
  - When Mr. Martin attended the D1 Board Meeting, he mentioned using the property next door to St. James-Santee as the next school.
  - Two years ago, Dr. McGinley told the D1 community that they would have a new school.
  - Kids from Mt. Pleasant are coming to the country for Oceanside Collegiate.
- 6. <u>Approval of the Minutes:</u> Mr. Colleton, Chairperson, called for the approval of the minutes for the April 26, 2016 meeting. Ms. Weathers moved and Ms. Geathers seconded the motion to approve the minutes with changes. The motion passed unanimously (5-0).

- 7. <u>Visitor:</u> Ms. Goodwine discussed the CCSD Referrals to the Office of Alternative Programs and Preliminary Data on Enrollment, Suspensions, and Expulsions for St. James-Santee, Lincoln Middle High School and district wide. She also shared:
  - New PBIS Coaches are being hired to teach life skills.
  - Social worker to be hired.
  - PBIS training will be implemented.
  - Twilight Program will be recommended in lieu of expulsion.
  - Student Code of Conduct to be revised.
  - Progressive discipline plan to be implemented.
  - Summit Program is closing Students will be placed at Daniel Jenkins or their home school.
  - Liberty Hill Special Ed K-8 students.
  - Daniel Jenkins  $-9^{th} 12^{th}$  grade students and through 21 years of age.

- 8. <u>Superintendent's Report:</u> Ms. Nichols shared that Dr. Davis had knee surgery and is recovering. St. James-Santee is hosting the Summer Feeding Program which allows community families to eat breakfast and lunch free at the school Mondays Fridays during the summer.

- Title I iPads/Chromebooks are being brought to St. James-Santee

- School items will be packed with care for opening of the new school.
- 10. **Public Communication**: Lincoln High School Graduation takes place June 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:00 PM
- 11. **Chairman's Report**: Mr. Colleton shared:
  - Recommendation that Ms. Jubar's position at Wando High School be an Associate Principal
  - Once Lincoln students go to Wando, they will be Wando Warriors.
  - There's already discussion about the new school not being called Lincoln.
  - People have been contacting Mr. Colleton wanting to get involved.

- Lawyers have called to contact them if community wants to sue CCSD.
- Gentleman contacted Mrs. Harrell need to file a class action lawsuit.
