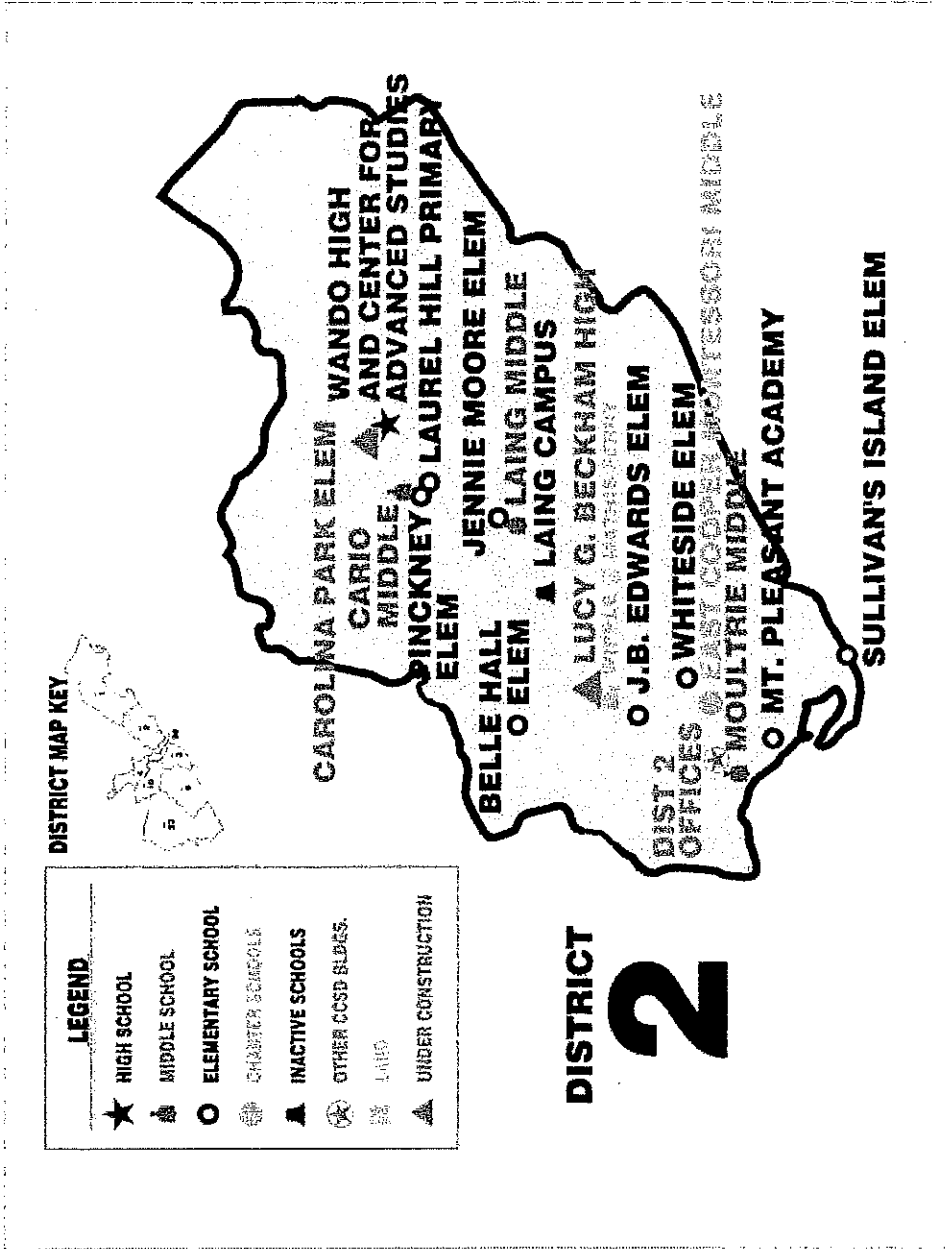

# Student Transfer Requests

The D2 Board continues to receive a high volume of student transfer requests from within and outside of D2.

- **2017-2018 school year - 333**
  - Intra District - 153
  - Inter District - 180
  
- **2018-2019 school year - 238 (to date)**
  - Intra District - 73
  - Inter District - 165

# Concerns

## **1) Awendaw D1 & D2 Joint Schools**

- The timeline for purchasing the land, starting construction, and opening the schools has not yet been decided by the County Board.
- Timing for attendance lines should follow.

## **2) Student Transfer Request Process**

- The integrity of the wait-list is being compromised by direct placement through the appeal process.

## **3) Student Discipline**

- Clear direction has not yet been provided as to possible consequences for end-of-year expulsions hearings.
- There is a lack of tracking and reporting back as to fulfillment of Probation Contract terms.

# Recommendations

## **1) Awendaw D 1 & D2 Joint Schools**

- Once the land is purchased, the County Board should set a timeline for building the D1 & D2 joint middle and high schools. Timing for attendance lines should follow.

## **2) Student Transfer Request Process**

- The student transfer request appeal procedure should be documented and followed.

## **3) Student Discipline**

- A county-wide procedure for end-of-year expulsion cases should be established.
- Regular progress reports regarding the fulfillment of Probation Contract terms should be provided to the constituent boards.
