MINUTES

- I. Call to Order: meeting was called to order at 6:05pm
In attendance: Sarah Johnson, Marty Belk, Kristen Cassi, Pamela Jouan-Goldman, Trey Tezza
- II. Approval of Agenda
Ms. Cassi moved, Ms. Belk seconded a motion to approve the agenda. Motion passed 5:0.

A motion was made by Ms. Johnson, seconded by Ms. Cassi to go into Executive Session. Motion passed 5:0.

A motion was made by Ms. Johnson, seconded by Ms. Cassi to go into Executive Session. Motion passed 5:0.

OPEN SESSION RECONVENED

- V. Vote on Executive Session Items
 - A. A motion was made by Ms. Johnson, seconded by Ms. Cassi that in lieu of expulsion Student A is placed at Turning Point Academy until successful completion of the program. If Student A does not successfully complete Turning Point Academy, student A is placed at Daniel Jenkins Academy until successful completion of the program. Student A is also on district probation through June 6, 2019. In addition, student is to turn in phone to Turning Point and school administrators each day and is also to be subject to random searches. Motion passed 5:0.
 - B. A motion was made by Ms. Johnson, seconded by Ms. Cassi that in lieu of expulsion Student B is returned to school on district probation. Student B is to turn in phone and electronic devices to school administrators each day and subject to random searches. Student B is to complete 10 hours of community service by June 6, 2019. Motion passed 5:0.
 - C. Ms. Jouan-Goldman moved and Ms. Cassi seconded a motion to deny Student Transfer Request #64727. Motion passed 5:0
 - D. Ms. Belk moved and Ms. Johnson seconded a motion to approve with direct placement Student Transfer request # 61190.
