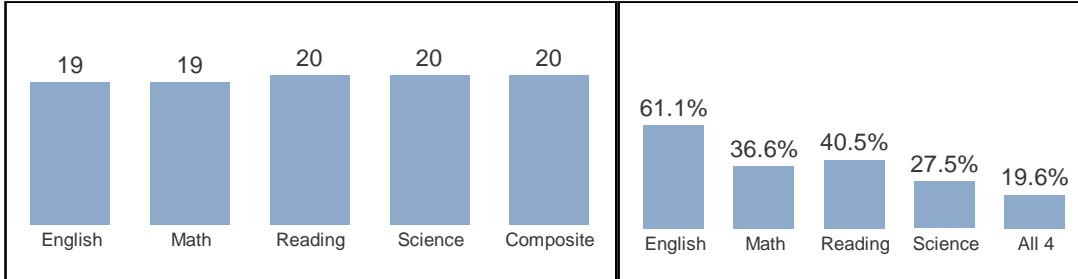

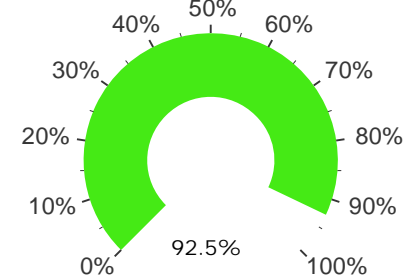

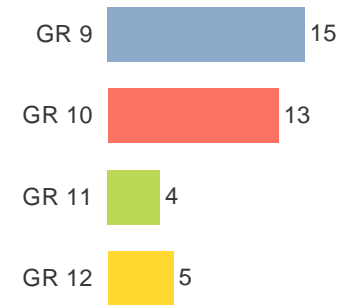
### Average 2017 ACT Scores (11th Grade)



## Graduation Rate



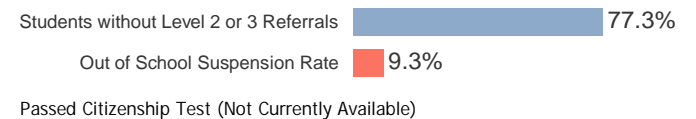

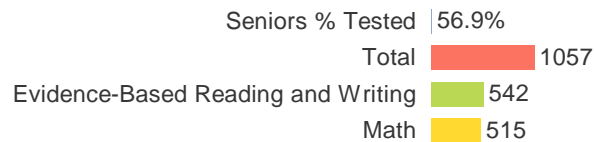

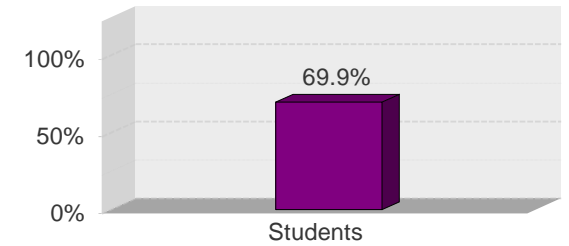

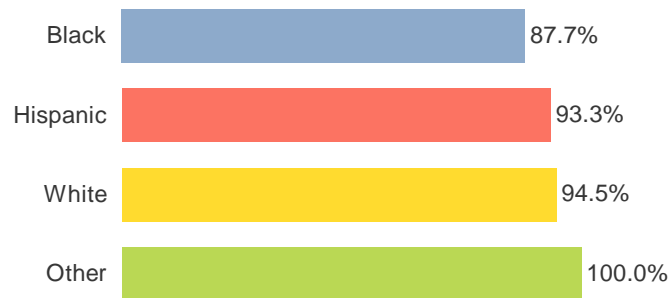
Students in Extracurriculars



Student Satisfaction with Learning Environment

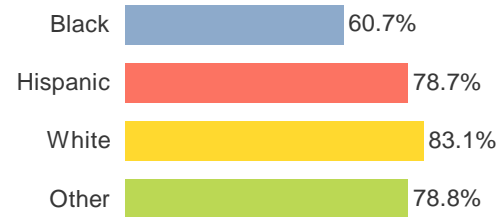


Graduation Rate
