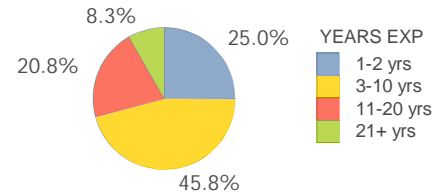

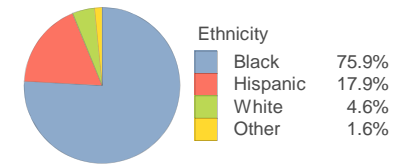

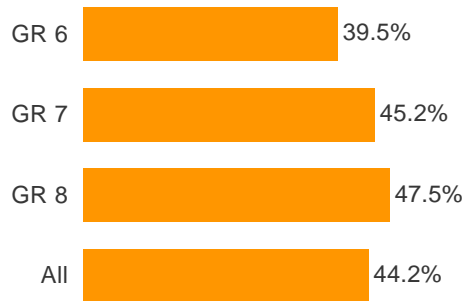


Student Ethnicity

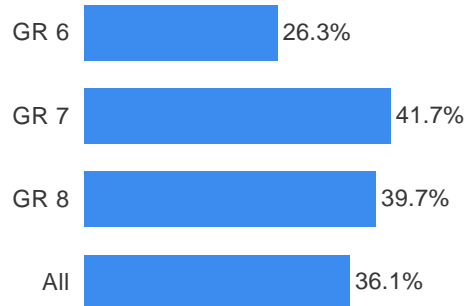


Percent of Students Meeting or Exceeding 1.0 Year Growth

MAP Reading 2016-17

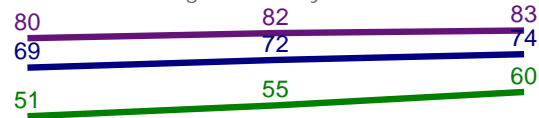


MAP Math 2016-17

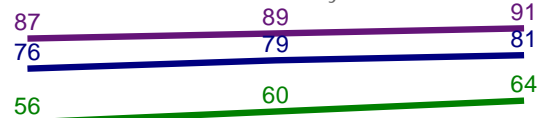


MAP Spring 2017 Median Student Percentile Rank

6-8 Reading Proficiency

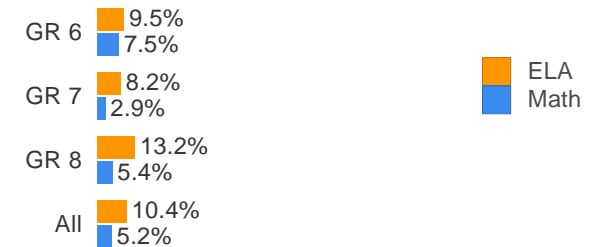


6-8 Math Proficiency

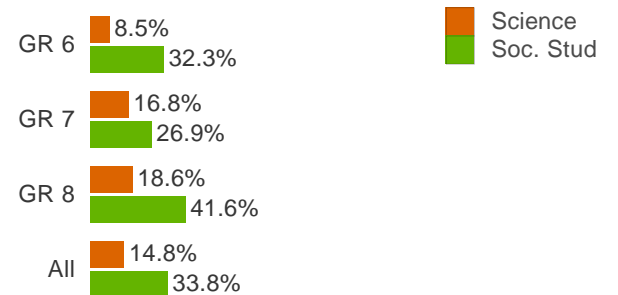

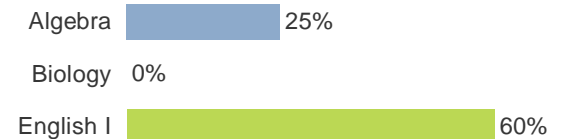

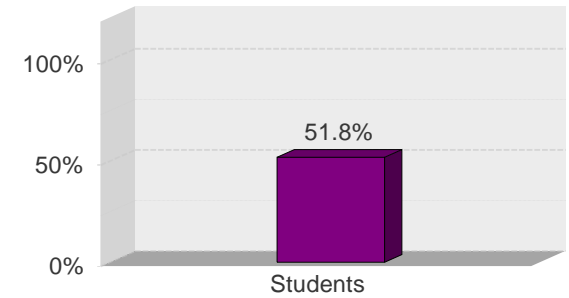

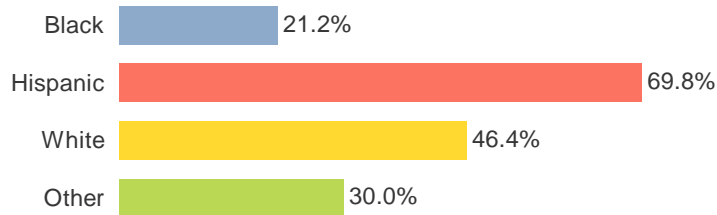
