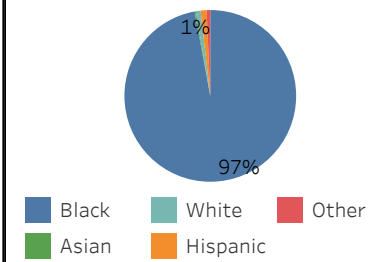

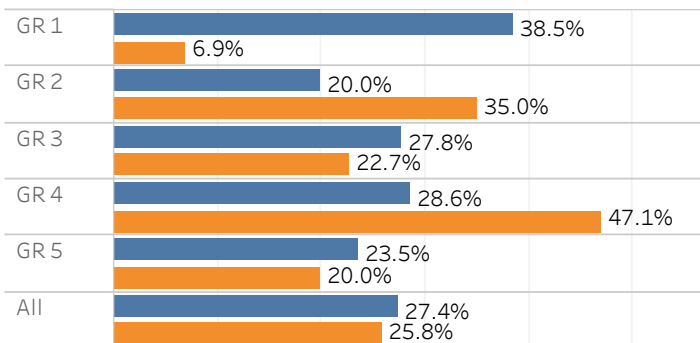

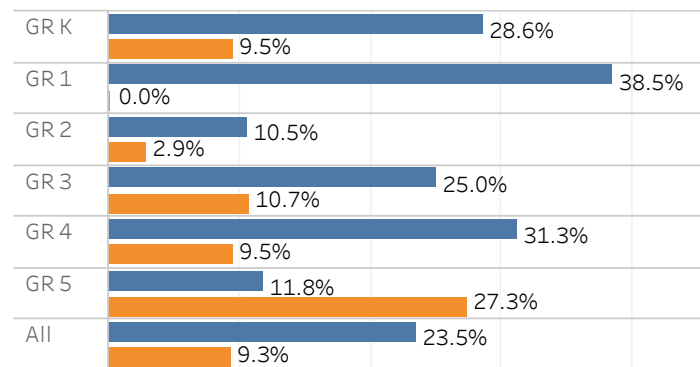

Growth: MAP Reading 2015-16

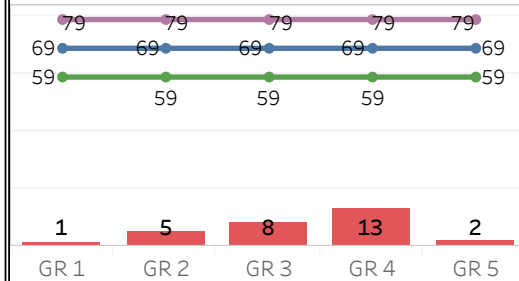


Growth: MAP Math 2015-16

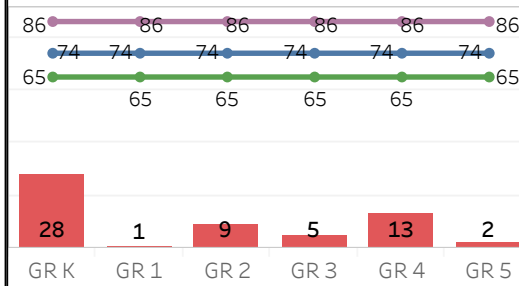

MAP Fall 2016 Reading Proficiency Grade Level Percentile Rank

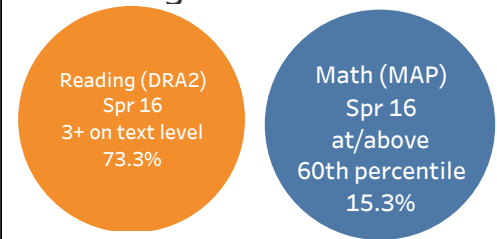


MAP Fall 2016 Math Proficiency Grade Level Percentile Rank

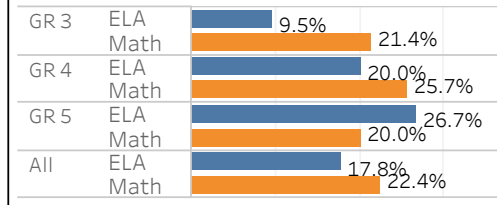

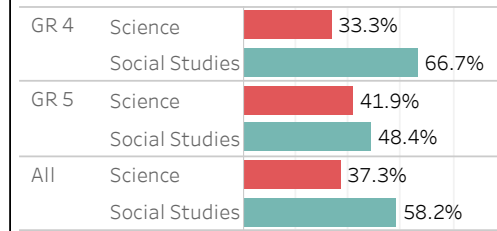

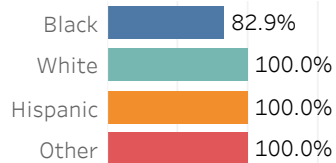

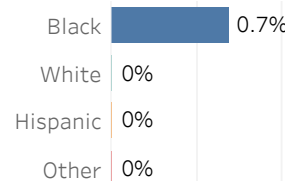
