Jeff Beckwith, North Charleston Elementary

Beckwith has served as interim principal at North Charleston Elementary since 2017. Beckwith began his career in education as a teacher. He went on to serve as assistant principal at Woodland High School in Dorchester County from 2004 to 2005, and at Cairo-Durham Middle/High in Cairo, New York. Beckwith served as principal of Williams Memorial Elementary in St. George, SC starting in 2007 prior to joining CCSD.

Judith Condon, Angel Oak Elementary

Condon has served as interim principal at Angel Oak Elementary since 2017. Condon began her teaching career as an art specialist at Hightower Trail Middle School in Cobb County in 2001 where she taught visual art and advanced visual art, along with reading and literacy for 11 years. Condon last served as Cobb County's Supervisor of Learning Design and Visual Arts starting in 2012 before joining the district.

Robin Fountain, James B. Edwards Elementary

Fountain has served as interim principal at James B. Edwards since 2017. After serving as a kindergarten and first grade teacher at Ashley River for seven years, Fountain moved to Georgia to work as a third grade teacher for the City Schools of Decatur. She eventually became an instructional coach for that school district, and in 2013, became the principal at Oakhurst Elementary where she worked until rejoining CCSD.

Brant Glover, West Ashley Middle Advanced Studies Magnet

Glover has served as interim principal at West Ashley Middle Advanced Studies Magnet since 2017. Glover began his career as a middle school Social Studies educator in Gainesville, GA. In 2013, Glover relocated from Georgia to South Carolina to serve as assistant principal at River Bluff High School before joining CCSD.
