Navy Week started in 2005, and this year's program in Charleston is the 226th Navy Week.

Navy military and civilian personnel are visiting nearly 50 school sites in the District, with representatives from the USS Constitution, Navy Fleet Forces Band, SPAWAR, Navy Meteorology and Oceanography Command, and the Naval Academy. Highlights will include a Seahawk helicopter which will land at six schools and band performances/clinics at five schools.
