

# CCSD BOARD OF TRUSTEES SPECIAL CALLED TELEPHONIC MEETING

A Special Called meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Charleston County School District was held on Friday, August 2, 2013, in the Edisto Conference Room at 75 Calhoun Street with the following members of the Board present: Mr. John Barter, Mr. Tom Ducker and Mr. Chris Fraser. ## II. CALL TO ORDER

At 12:33 pm, Mr. Fraser called the meeting to order.
