DISTANCE, ONLINE AND VIRTUAL EDUCATION

Purpose: To establish the board's vision and the basic structure for providing distance education technology-delivered courses as an alternative means of instruction for students.

The superintendent may not provide for interactive distance education unless it is consistent with instructional goals. Charleston County School District shallAll technology-delivered programs offered will be consistent with the District's and State's academic standards and instructional goals, ensuring both rigor of the course and quality of instruction. The superintendent or his/her designee will establish a committee to review instructional materials periodically to ensure they meet program standards and are effective expenditures. Distance, online and virtual education courses shall provide the opportunity for substantial, personal and timely interactions between staff and students and among students.
