CONTENT AND CREDIT RECOVERY

Code IKADD Issued

Purpose: To establish the board's vision and basic structure for student participation in content and credit recovery programs.

All credit and content recovery programs will be consistent with the District's and State's academic standards and instructional goals and aligned to the South Carolina Uniform Grading Policy. School administration, operating under the credit recovery guidance provided by the District, will coordinate with designated staff members to identify students appropriate for participation in content and credit recovery programs. The Superintendent or designee will establish a committee to review instructional materials periodically to ensure they meet program standards and are effective expenditures. Credit and content recovery programs may be limited by the availability of space, facilitators, and appropriate computer-based content and/or due to budgetary constraints.

The superintendent is responsible for maintaining administrative procedures that shall facilitate this policy.
