

**NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY REQUIREMENTS  
2020-2021**

NHS Guidelines:

National Honor Society members must set an ideal example for the students of West Ashley High School. Members must demonstrate the qualities of leadership, character, and service which you pledged to uphold upon induction into the society. Members must maintain an exemplary discipline record. A referral for cheating will result in an automatic revocation of membership. Suspension due to fighting, drugs, or alcohol will also result in automatic revocation of membership. Finally, members must maintain an overall **4.25 average** and complete the required service hours or he/she will not be able to walk with honors on graduation day.

Responsibilities:

- Maintain a **4.25** (weighted) average
- Take at least two Honors/AP level courses each year
- Complete and authenticate 20 service hours per semester Submitted on time in February and June (40 for the year) regardless of full or part-time enrollment status in classes.
- Participate in all fundraisers
- Practice and participate in the Induction Ceremony
- Attend meetings on the second Monday of the month (only **2 excused** absences allowed)
- Participate in school service projects
- Fees:
  - Seniors - \$40.00 (pays for state/national membership, ceremony costs, t-shirts, and graduation stoles)
  - Juniors- \$25.00 (pays for state/national membership, ceremony costs, and t-shirts)

The responsibilities are not negotiable.
